All Missouri students will graduate college and career ready.					
SUMMARY:					
The Riverview Gardens School District was classified as unaccredited as of July 1, 2007, per State Board of Education action. The Riverview Gardens School District did not regain accreditation within two years as required under state law (Section 162.081, RSMo.), and the State Board of Education appointed a Special Administrative Board (SAB) in May 2010.					
Because of significant progress on the 2015 Annual Performance Report (APR), the Riverview Gardens School District requested that the State Board of Education consider reclassifying the district in the fall of 2015. In December 2015, the State Board of Education declined to reclassify the district because the district had not scored in or above the provisional range on the APR over multiple years.					
Due to statutorily required changes to the statewide assessment system for the spring 2016 administration, student achievement data needed for the APR will be available much later than is routine, thus delaying production of the APR and subsequent classification decisions until very late in 2016. The Board acknowledged that these factors are beyond the control of the Riverview Gardens School District and reclassification at that time would be disruptive to students and their families.					
In December 2015, the State Board of Education directed the Department to develop a method to evaluate the progress of Riverview Gardens School District for the purposes of reclassification by June 2016. The evaluation was to include current systems reviews and measures of student performance, including academic achievement.

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education use the proposed framework as a basis for a reclassification decision in Riverview Gardens School District.
